

REFLECTIONS FROM FATHER DAN BEDEL'S TALK

"Bringing and Living Faith, Hope, and Love in the Home."

- 1. Extend your Prayer Life: Throughout the day and together as a family when possible.
- 2. Remember the Dead: Share your family history, the stories and identity. Honor the dead and pray for them. It makes death normal.
- 3. Admit your Mistakes: Know that you do not have to be perfect. You are not unique in your sins.
- 4. *Manual Labor*: It provides a sense of contribution and ownership in the family and elsewhere. It causes us to feel and be part of the family.
- 5. *Technology*: In the past, technology gave us more time to do important things, especially in and for the family. Today, technology eats up our time. It has become the central object.
- 6. Education: Know your Faith: Are there books in your home? "A house without books is like a soul without life," says Chesterton. Education begins with ourselves.
- 7. Everything in our Home Forms Us: We are sensual beings reacting to what surrounds us. Religious images are important. Do they have a prominent place in your home?

Home should be a refuge where we can heal and recharge for our encounters with the world, sharing the virtues of FAITH, HOPE, and LOVE.
