
# August 29 ~ Twenty-Second Sunday of Ordínary Tíme

**MISSIONARY PRIEST** – Next weekend, Fr. Paul Gins of the Order of Friar Servants of Mary will talk to us about their missionary work in KwaZulu-Natal, Republic of South Africa. The main task of the missionaries today continues to be the proclamation of the Gospel and the establishment of viable Catholic communities. Other ministries include education, primary health care centers, providing funds to improve the water system to root out malaria, building of homes for the very poor, and the formation of the young Zulu seminarians.
