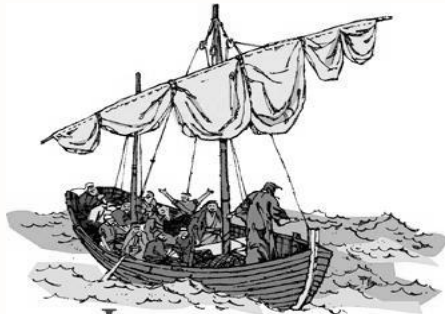

Therefore, wake him up, arouse yourself and make this prayer, "Teacher...we are perishing."

**CATECHIST** – A catechist for the kindergarten class for the year 2021-2022 is needed. If you are interested, please see or call Patty Simon, 689-4100.

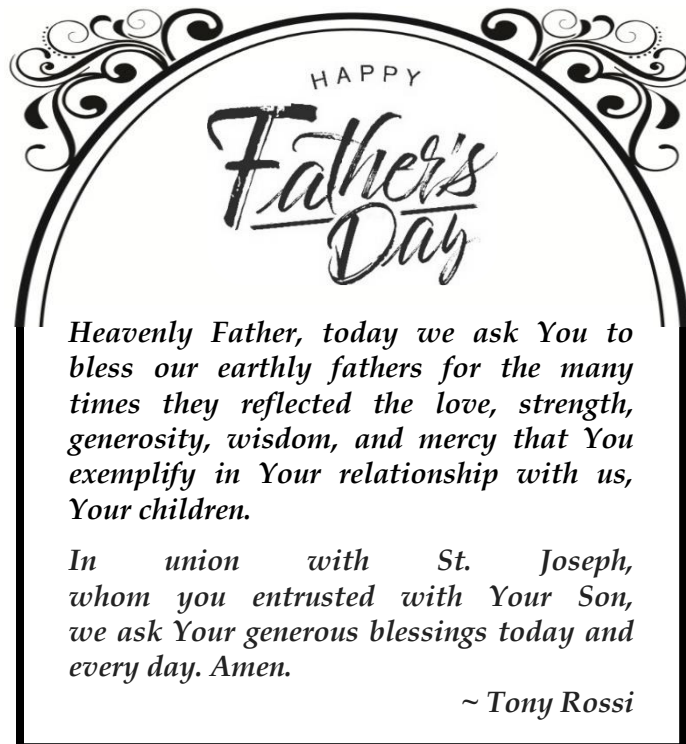

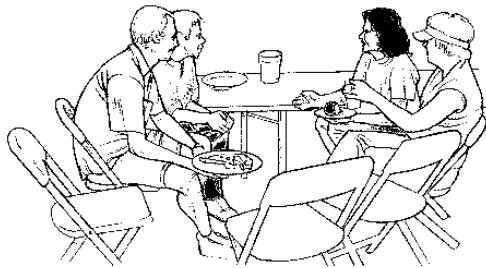
