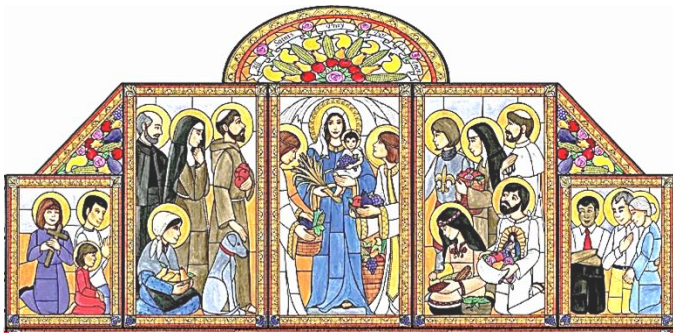


October 29 – Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA – The Wreaths Across America theme for 2023 is Serve and Succeed. There is a printout in the entrances of church of all of the veterans buried in our cemetery. Please contact the church office if you know of a veteran in our cemetery who is not on that list, or if the information on the list is not accurate. There are brochures to take home, fill out, and send in if you want to sponsor a wreath for our cemetery. There is also a copy of that brochure with a QR code to scan if you want to go online and buy a wreath that way. The cost of one wreath is \$17.00, two wreaths are \$34.00, five wreaths are \$85.00, 10 wreaths are \$170.00, or you can make a Custom Number of Wreaths sponsorship.

Also, there is a Day of Giving Ad, where the money given on November 3 is for an endowment where any donations made on that day will be matched 50%. This will not be for this year's program but will help in future years to bring down the cost of the wreaths. Please help us put a wreath on all of the 73 veterans' graves in St. Maurice Cemetery.
